



BADMINTON

1. DATE

1.1 The Championship is held at least one week prior to the WOSSAA Championship. The Junior Championship is held prior to the WOSSAA Championship, in order to satisfy WOSSAA regulation.

2. LOCATION

2.1 A suitable location is to be determined by the convenor.

3. EVENTS

3.1 The events to be conducted are:

- i) Girls singles
- ii) Girls doubles
- iii) Boys singles
- iv) Boys doubles
- v) Mixed doubles

4. TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE AND PROCEDURES

4.1 The Tournament will be a true Double Elimination Tournament.

5. SEEDING

5.1 The convenor will seed the draw where possible.

6. ENTRY AND ENTRY FEES

6.1 Each school will be allowed two entries per event.

6.2 No player may enter more than one event.

7. ELIGIBILITY

- 7.1 A player may not compete in both the Junior and Senior Championship.
- 7.2 Each player must be eligible for competition under the Huron-Perth and WOSSAA constitutions.
- 7.3 If eligible players are unable to compete at WOSSAA, the next highest conference finisher may be substituted. Substitution on the day of the WOSSAA tournament must be authorized by the conference convenor in order to be allowed.
- 7.4 Each player who qualifies for an event at his conference championship may compete only in that same event at WOSSAA.

8. RULES AND OFFICIALS

- 8.1 The rules of the Ontario Badminton Association shall govern the play at the Huron-Perth Championship, with the following exceptions:
 - i) Play will commence at 4 - 4 for all matches played prior to the rounds involving team points (5th & 6th place)
- 8.1 The convenor shall be responsible for supplying a qualified official as referee and any other necessary officials.

9. UNIFORMS

- 9.1 Plain whites are preferred but school uniforms are acceptable. Playing in warm-ups is not allowed.

10. EQUIPMENT

- 10.1 The shuttle cocks must be the same type as that approved for the OFSAA Championships for that year and the type must be indicated to conference convenors on the WOSSAA entry and information forms.
- 10.2 All players must wear either CSA approved safety glasses or shatter-proof prescription glasses at all times during Huron-Perth competition.

11. AWARDS

- 11.1 Individual: Medallions will be awarded to first and second place finishers in each event
- 11.2 Team Huron-Perth Pennant and Trophy is awarded to the school accumulating the highest point total from all event and all competitors. Points shall be awarded as follows:
- 1st - 10 points
 - 2nd - 7 points
 - 3rd - 5 points
 - 4th - 3 points
 - 5th + 6th - 1 point

12. WOSSA ENTRY

- 12.1 The top four finishers in each Junior event shall advance to WOSSAA. The top four finishers in each Senior shall advance to WOSSAA. If a competitor(s) is unable to compete at WOSSAA, the next highest finisher may take their place. No substitutions are allowed should one of a doubles or mixed team be unable to compete at WOSSAA.

13. CONVENORSHIP

- 13.1 The Convenorship will rotate on a yearly basis from:
