



## HURON, PERTH AND HURON-PERTH CURLING

### 1. LEAGUE PLAY AND CHAMPIONSHIP DATES:

1.1 There shall be a 3 day league schedule for curling. The host school may charge a nominal fee to cover the costs of the curling club rental.

1.2 The Huron-Perth competition shall be held on a date a minimum of one week prior to the WOSSAA competition. It shall be hosted by Huron County in odd numbered years and by Perth County in even numbered years.

1.3 That the HP Championship be formatted as follows:

Semi-Finals:

- i) Perth #1 vs Huron # 2
- ii) Huron #1 vs Perth # 2

Finals

Winner i vs Winner ii

Consolation Finals

Loser i vs Loser ii

1.4 Both Huron and Perth Conferences shall hold separate championships prior to the Huron-Perth Finals. These County Championships shall be two day events, subject to the number of teams. (Should the number warrant it, a single day competition shall be held)

## 2. **AWARDS**

2.1 Huron Conference Pennant - Boys and Girls.  
Perth Conference Pennant - Boys and Girls  
Huron-Perth Championship Pennant - Boys and Girls

2.2 Huron-Perth Medallions: 5 gold medals shall be awarded to the winning team and 5 silver medals shall be awarded to the second placed team..

### 3. ENTRIES

- 3.1 The convener may charge an entry fee to cover the costs. The entry fee will not be used to cover lunch expenses for players and/or coaches.
- 3.2 Huron and Perth counties will compete separately and each advance their 1st. and 2nd. place teams to the Huron Perth competition which alternates each year between counties. Perth to host in even numbered years; Huron to host in odd numbered years.
- 3.3 Only schools that operate a curling program in the school are eligible for Huron Perth competition.

### 4. W.O.S.S.A.A ENTRIES

- 4.1 One Boys' and one Girls' team will represent the conference at WOSSAA.
- 4.2 A curler who has played for one school curling team that has not qualified for WOSSAA may not be added either as a player or as a spare to a second curling team from the same school that has qualified for the WOSSAA curling championship.

### 5. PLAYING RULES

- 5.1 The Huron, Perth and Huron-Perth play-downs will follow the current Canadian Curling Association Rules at the time of the play-down.
- 5.2 The Huron and Perth divisional curling play-downs will use a double knock-out format. The HP championships follow single elimination-consolation format.
- 5.3 The Huron and Perth Divisional curling competition will be filled with 8 teams. Each school has one entry and the remaining spaces will be filled by other teams with the best results based on the league games.
- 5.4 All competitors are expected to dress in uniforms that are neat, clean and which maintain the integrity of the school's name, colours and logo. No sports club insignia on uniforms shall be permitted. A sports club is defined as a community, provincial or national organization whose primary purpose is participation in organized competition.
- 5.5 All W.O.S.S.A.A. curling rules will apply.
- 5.6 It is strongly recommended that the convenor find an outside curling referee to

oversee the championships (County and Conference).
