PLAYING RULES

- 5.1 The Huron, Perth and Huron-Perth play-downs will follow the current Canadian Curling Association Rules at the time of the play-down.
- 5.2 The Huron and Perth divisional curling play-downs will use a double knock-out format. The HP championships follow single elimination-consolation format.
- 5.3 The Huron and Perth Divisional curling competition will be filled with 8 teams. Each school has one entry and the remaining spaces will be filled by other teams with the best results based on the league games.
- 5.4 All competitors are expected to dress in uniforms that are neat, clean and which maintain the integrity of the school's name, colours and logo. No sports club insignia on uniforms shall be permitted. A sports club is defined as a community, provincial or national organization whose primary purpose is participation in organized competition.
- 5.5 All W.O.S.S.A.A. curling rules will apply.
- 5.6 It is strongly recommended that the convenor find an outside curling referee to Huron-Perth to oversee the championships (County and Conference).

Lunch: Students are welcome to bring their own lunch, or purchase from the curling club. Lunch choices are generally burger/wrap/sandwich/chicken fingers with fries for approx \$10. Let the Madill coaches know approximate numbers of purchased lunches the morning of the event so the club can prepare the appropriate amount. Drinks and snacks are also for sale.
